- Majority written 1000-400 BC



- · Voice of prophecy stilled (Intertestamental Period)
- · Resumption with John the Baptist
- Not to say that the Jews stopped writing (Class 2)
- 2. Growth of Tanakh
- · Torah (Law/Instruction)
- Nevi'im (Prophets)
- · Kethuvim (Writings)
- TaNaKh (acronym)
- · Samaritan canon: Note that this group accepted only the Torah (slightly modified)
- 3. Expansion of Torah, Nevi'im, and Kethuvim: a few illustrations
- · Torah: Exodus to Deuteronomy; final version in Babylon
- · Nevi'im: Isa 8: Jer 36
- · Kethuvim: Psalter; Proverbs
- Incompleteness of OT
- · Covenant entails writing (Jer 31)
- · Hebrew OT ends in suspense: Chronicles (new beginning under Cyrus)
- · Greek OT ends in suspense: Malachi (herald preceding coming of Lord)
- Second Moses (Deut 18) entails further scripture
