
Who was Polycarp?

- Disciple of (and ordained by) the Apostle John
- 2nd –century bishop of Smyrna (Izmir, Turkey)










Who was Polycarp?

- Disciple of (and ordained by) the Apostle John
- 2nd –century bishop of Smyrna (Izmir, Turkey)
- Sole surviving work 'Letter to the Philippians'
- Regarded as one of three 'Chief Apostolic Fathers' (with St. Clement of Rome and St. Ignatius of Antioch)
- AD 69-155 (86 years-ish)



Who was Polycarp?

- Spanned a time between the end of the apostolic era and the emergence of catholic Christianity
- Opposition to Gnostic movement (particularly Marcion, charismatic teacher)
- Development of the monepiscopal form of ecclesiastical organization
- The formation of the canon of the New testament



Polycarp – Letter to the Philippians

- A complex hortatory (*aiming to exhort*) letter that:
- 1. Combines common letter types (encouragement, advice, and admonition)
- 2. Response to the Philippian's request for a discussion on Righteousness
- 3. The problem of Valens (a money hungry leader)

Polycarp – Orthodoxy & Orthopraxy

- Orthodoxy authorized or accepted theory, doctrine, or practice
- Orthopraxy correct or moral conduct.

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1 Timothy 4:16 (NIV) - Watch your life and doctrine closely. Persevere in them, because if you do, you will save both yourself and your hearers.

Polycarp – Orthodoxy & Orthopraxy

- Orthodoxy authorized or accepted theory, doctrine, or practice
- Orthopraxy correct or moral conduct.

Polycarp believed that wrong behaviors were *primia facie* evidence of wrong beliefs, and that wrong beliefs inevitably produced wrong behaviors. Further, wrong beliefs and behaviors are characteristic of outsiders, not insiders.

Polycarp – Letter to the Philipians

4:1b – ...knowing, therefore, that we brought nothing into the world and cannot take anything out, let us arm ourselves with the weapons of righteousness, and let us first teach ourselves to follow the commandment of the Lord.

- Apparently written by eyewitnesses (15.1) not long after the event (18.1)
- The issue: Lord Christ vs. Lord Caesar (10.1)



The Martyrdom of Polycarp

- Apparently written by eyewitnesses (15.1) not long after the event (18.1)
- The issue: Lord Christ vs. Lord Caesar (10.1)
- Set an example for next 150 yrs:
 - a matter of divine calling
 - concern for salvation of others
 - endurance in the midst of suffering



The Martyrdom of Polycarp

- Alternate title: The Teaching of the Lord to the Gentiles by the Twelve Apostles
- No known copy to exist until 1873!



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- Three Sections
 - Two Way of Life & Death

(summary of basic instruction about the Christian life to be taught to those who were preparing for baptism and church membership)

- Church practice & order
- brief apocalyptic section





- The 'church order' section also bears evidence of change over time (e.g., compare 11.4 with 12.1, or note the intrusive character of 14.1-3)
- A remarkable wide range of dates has been proposed: before 50 AD to the third century or later



though a date at the end of the first century seems more probable
