

- Possibly even a '3rd letter' that is lost (ref 1 Cor 5:9)

Letter(s) to the Corinthians

• 1st Corinthians Letter Issues:

- Factionalism / Unity within the Church (4 chapters)
- Sexual immorality
- Self defense (Chapter 9)
- Matters of Conscious
- Worship issues (women head covering & communion)
- Spiritual gifts
- Love 1 Corinthians 13
- Resurrection
- Collection for the poor in Jerusalem

Communion

Very traditional to 'celebrate the identity of any group' with a meal known as 'the Greco-Roman banquet'.

Composed of two parts (dinner & a show):

- The main meal
- The 'entertainment' or philosophical discussion
 - The second part began by sharing a cup of wine and blessing God. It was this '2nd / dessert' cup that Jesus uses for his 'blood'

Letter(s) to the Corinthians

2nd Corinthians Letter:

- Probably written as a 'combination of letters' would have written at intervals of several months
- Timothy visits Corinth → situation had not improved (Acts 19:21-22) → Paul makes visit; refers to it as 'painful' (2 Cor 2:1) → won't visit again & writes letter(s) (2:4)...which possibly became Chap 10-13 → Titus visits Corinth and found community repentant (2 Cor 7:5-13) → early fall of 57a.d...Paul receives good news and writes (what will become) 2 Corinthians
