- a hands on class to make your own clay tablet




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
#### Dates of NT Authorship





Pergamum – built on land that juts into water. Worship of Zeus, Dionysus, & Asklepios (god of healing). Library of 200K volumes (2<sup>nd</sup> only to Library of Alexandria).

**Smyrna** – Port City – cult of emperor worship. Home of Polycarp



**Ephesus** – largest City major trade city Temple of Artemis (Diana)

#### Promontory into Aegean Sea




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Thyatira – famous for dyeing (home of Lydia – seller of purple fabrics). Located in a valley – military base for Alexander the Great **Sardis** – Wealthy city known for woolen fabric & carpets. First city to mint coinage (600BC). Stream carried gold dust from nearby mountains



Philadelphia –

commercial center located on elevated ground overlooking the fertile plain of the Hermus (Gediz) River

Laodicea – prosperous, well-respected financial center, textile (black wool) & leading medical school produced eye salve.

**Ephesus** – largest City major trade city Temple of Artemis (Diana) Sister Cities:

**Colossae** – mountain spring cold, fresh water **Hierapolis** – famous for hot, therapeutic mineral springs

#### 'Reward' for Repentance

Ancient Name	Modern Name	Reward for Repentance
Ephesus	Selçuk	grant the privilege to eat the fruit from the tree of life, which is in the Paradise of God
Smyrna	Izmir	give crown of life (not be hurt by the second death)
Pergamum	Bergama	eat some of the hidden manna - receive a white stone with a new name engraved (that no one knows except the one who receives it)
Thyatira	Akhisar	give authority and power over the nations - give him the Morning Star (deeper understanding / relationship with Jesus)
Sardis	Salihli/Manisa	dressed in white clothing - never blot out name (from book of life) - acknowledge his name before my Father & angels
Philadelphia	Alaşehir	- no repentance needed; be made into a pillar in temple; write on him the name of My God
Laodicea	Pamukkale/Denizli	sit beside me on my throne




#### Rev 5-8 The 7 Trumpets



#### 666 (Commentary from the AMP Bible)

This is not actually three sixes (or the equivalent in Greek or Hebrew letters), as commonly represented. Such a combination would not be used; and if it were, the sum would then be only eighteen, because in alphabet-based numbering systems like ancient Hebrew and Greek, place values are not used (10's, 100's etc.), but the letters are treated more like Roman numerals. What John is most likely indicating is that the letters of the name will add up to 666 (the best Greek manuscripts have the number spelled out), and there could be many different combinations of letters that would do so. Determining the values of the individual letters is another matter. John probably assumed that the name would be Hebrew or Greek, and in Hebrew vowels for the most part are not represented as letters. Further complications arise when names from other nationalities are considered, and are converted for valuation. For example, at various times it has been argued that the name "Nero Caesar" adds up to 666 when transliterated to Hebrew as NRWN QSR (according to the Greek form); but in the Talmud, the name is transliterated as NYRWN QYSR, which totals 686. Also, the original Latin form of the name (without the second "n"), if converted directly to Hebrew, adds up to 616, and a few ancient manuscripts had that number.




## Rev 16:21 – And giant hailstones, as heavy as a talent fell from the sky on the people...

https://physics.stackexchange.com/questions/ 216952/terminal-velocity-of-100lb-hail Air drag is given by

$$F_d = \frac{1}{2} \rho v^2 A C_D$$

where  $\rho$  is the density of air (variable, depending on temperature etc - 1.2 kg/m<sup>3</sup> is a reasonable approximation), v is the velocity. A is the projected area, and  $C_D$  is the drag factor - which is a function of shape and Reynolds number. o, o is an OK approximation but it depends on the velocity see this graph (from http://www.islandons.org/LEOSibio/SPBLGUs.GIF).



The terminal velocity is reached when the force is equal to the weight, mg.

We get A from the mass and density. Density of ice is about 920 kg/m $^3$ , so a 45 kg sphere of ice has a radius r found by solving

$$\frac{4}{3}\pi r^3 \rho_{tcc} = m_{tcc}$$

$$r = \sqrt[3]{\frac{3m_{tcc}}{4\pi}} = 0.23m$$

This makes the projected area  $A=\pi r^2=0.16m^2$ . So the terminal velocity is found by solving for  $v_1$  and our initial estimate is:

$$v = \sqrt{\frac{2mg}{\rho AC_D}} = \sqrt{\frac{2*45*9.8}{1.2*0.16*0.5}} = 100 \text{ m/s}$$

If the hailstone is irregular shape, its terminal velocity will change a bit - but not a lot. Depending on the shape, it can be lower or higher.

Now that we have the velocity, we can look at the Reynolds number. A sphere of 0.23 m radius moving at 100 m/s in air has a Reynolds number of about 1.6 · 10 $^6$ , and according to the above graph that results in a much lower  $C_0$  of approximately 0.2. Repeating the calculation with that lower draph coefficient we find v = 150 m/s. In principle, we could compute a new R, and repeat... but 1 don't think the accuracy of the estimate warrants that.

150 m/s is 50% faster than the initial estimate! Note that I rounded my results - precisely because these kinds of errors quickly dominate the result, and giving an answer like  $^{\circ}_{1.56}$ 6 m/s $^{\circ}_{1.06}$ 6, which is what my calculator came up with), gives a false impression that the answer is not 151.70 r 151.51 when in fact, a lot of estimating went into this and 1501 s about a 2500 at 2500 at 251.

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
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# 150 m/s or 335 miles per hour

Air drag is given

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150 m/s is 50% faster than the initial estimate! Note that I rounded my results - precisely because these kinds of errors quickly dominate the result, and giving an answer like  $^{*}$ 5.46 m/s $^{*}$ 1, (which is what my calculator came up with), gives a false impression that the answer is not 151.7 or 151.5 when in fact, a lot of estimating went into this and 150 is about as good as you can get.

5 And He who sits on the throne said, "Behold, I am making all things new." Also He said, "Write, for these words are faithful and true [they are accurate, incorruptible, and trustworthy]." 6 And He said to me, "It is done. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. To the one who thirsts I will give [water] from the fountain of the water of life without cost. 7 He who overcomes [the world by adhering faithfully to Christ Jesus as Lord and Savior] will inherit these things, and I will be his God and he will be My son. 8 But as for the cowards and unbelieving and abominable [who are devoid of character and personal integrity and practice or tolerate immorality], and murderers, and sorcerers [with intoxicating drugs], and idolaters and occultists [who practice and teach false religions], and all the liars [who knowingly deceive and twist truth], their part will be in the lake that blazes with fire and brimstone, which is the second death."


